Opening – Mobilising Capital for the Blue Economy: From Blended Finance to Scalable Investment

- The panel will analyse the conditions required to mobilise private capital at scale, including the structuring role of blended finance and the alignment of incentives between public institutions, development banks and investors.
- It will explore how to expand geographically diversified investment pipelines, particularly in emerging and coastal economies where opportunities remain underdeveloped but strategically critical.
- The discussion will aim to position the blue economy as a mature investment space, capable of delivering risk-adjusted returns alongside measurable environmental and socio-economic outcomes.

Shipping at the Crossroads: Financing the Transition to a Low-Carbon Ocean Economy

- The session will examine the scale and structure of investment required to transition the shipping sector towards low-carbon models, spanning fleet renewal, alternative fuels and port infrastructure.
- It will assess how regulatory clarity, standard-setting and international coordination can reduce uncertainty and unlock more predictable investment environments.
- The discussion will focus on pathways to accelerate capital deployment into viable solutions, positioning shipping as a central pillar of a decarbonised and resilient ocean economy.
